Shared in his life with us.

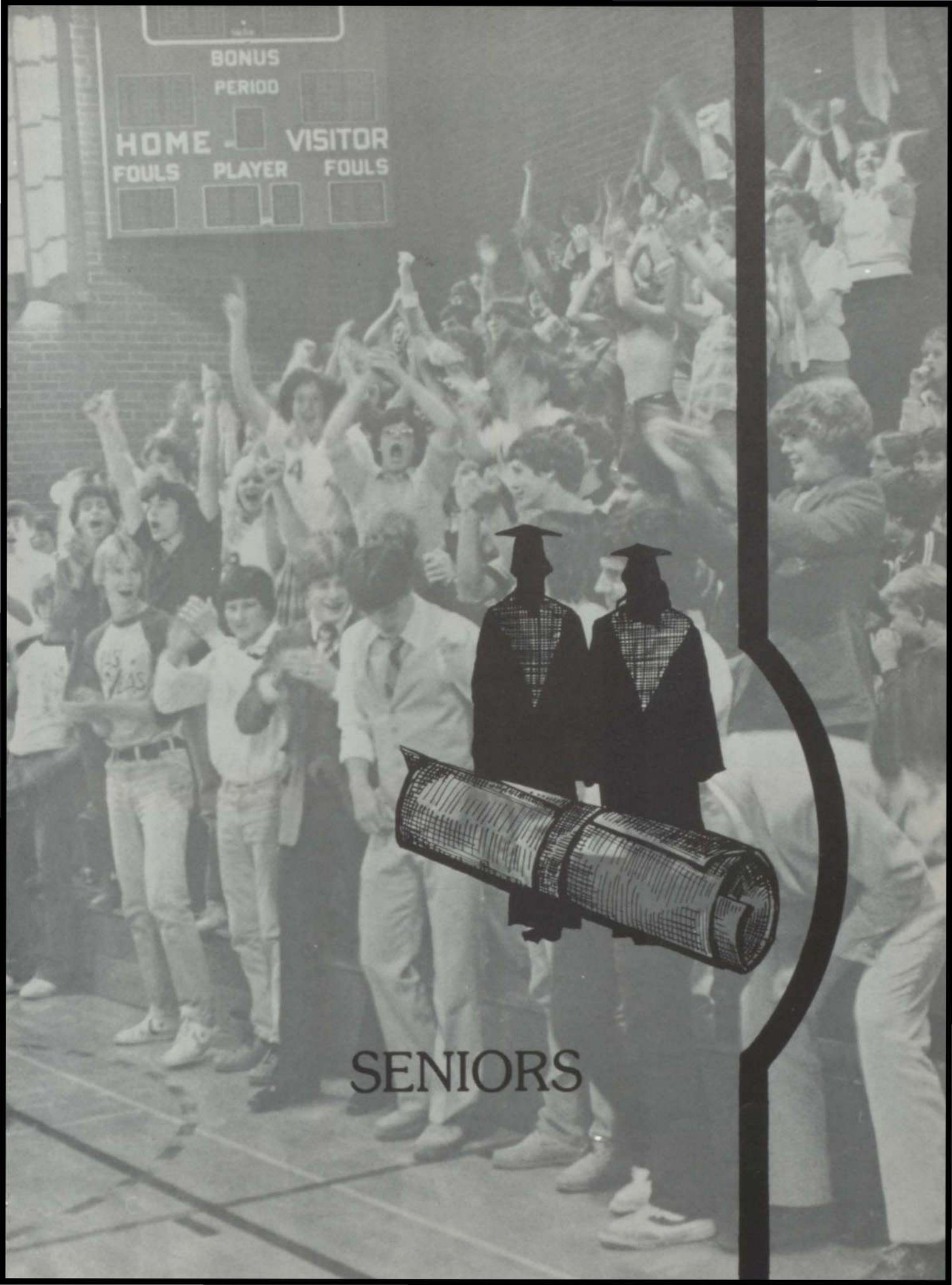
