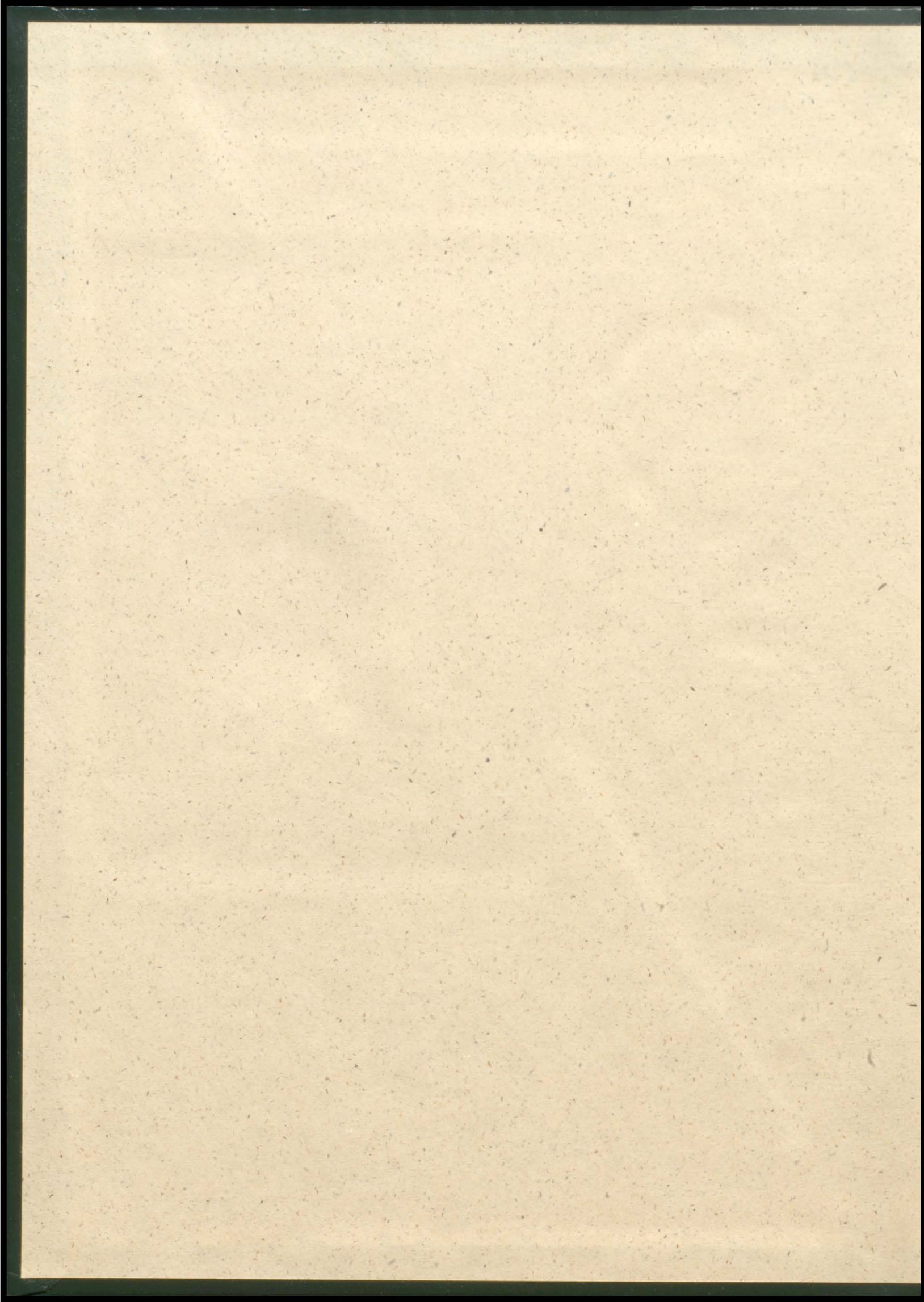

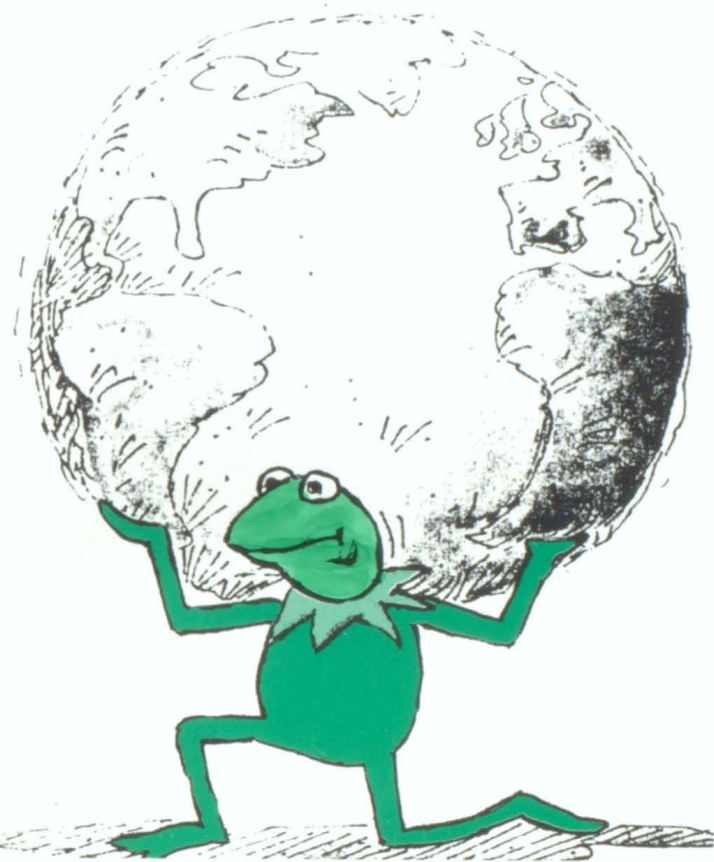

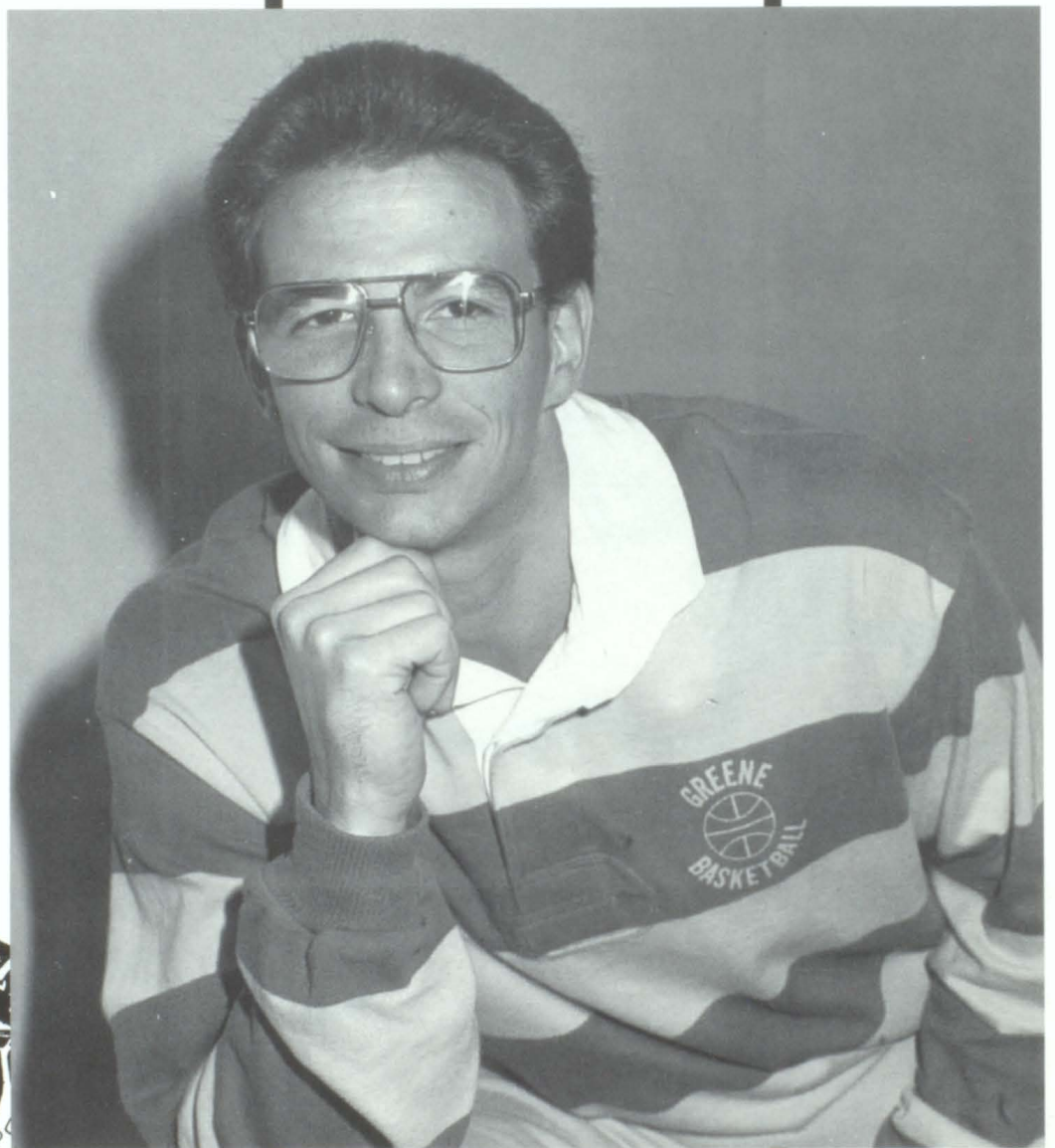

Things go wrong.

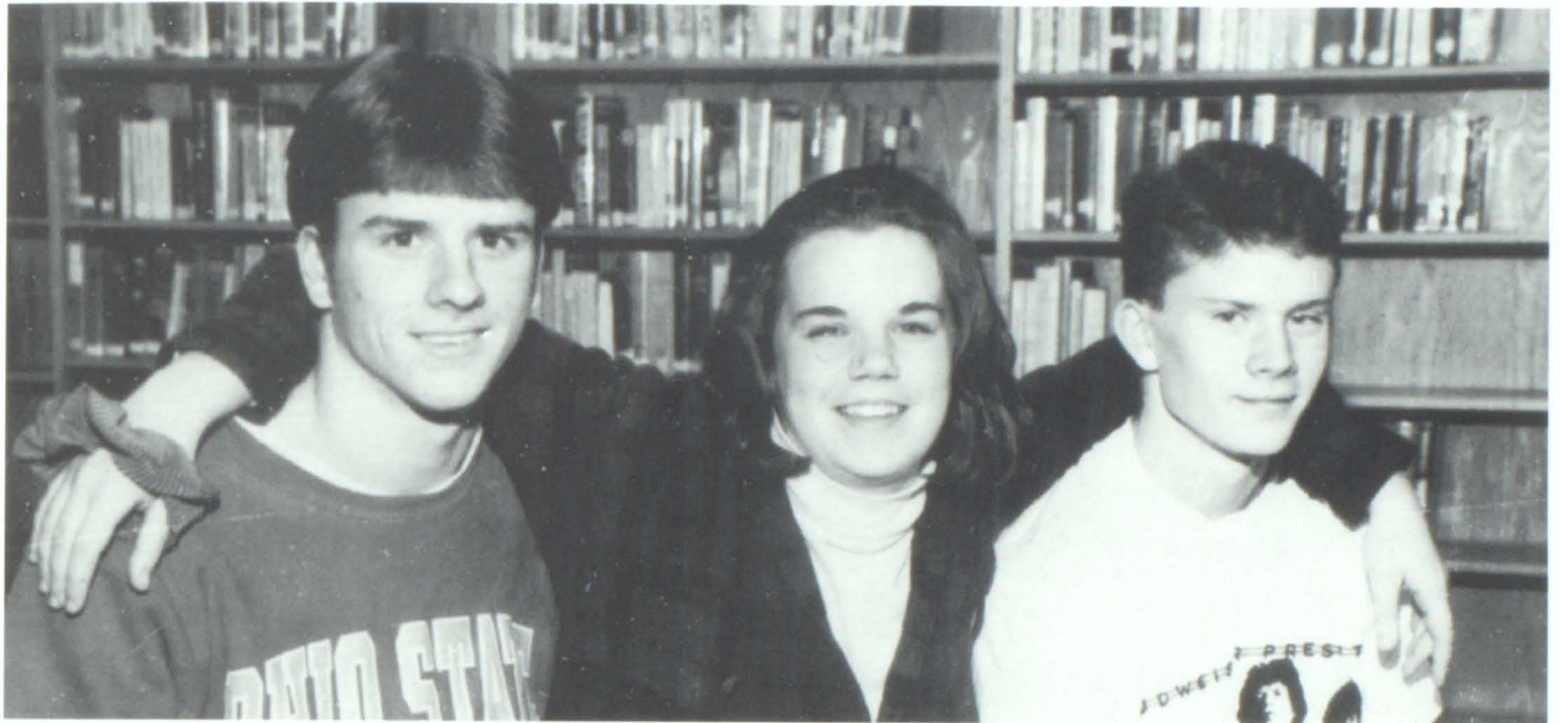
