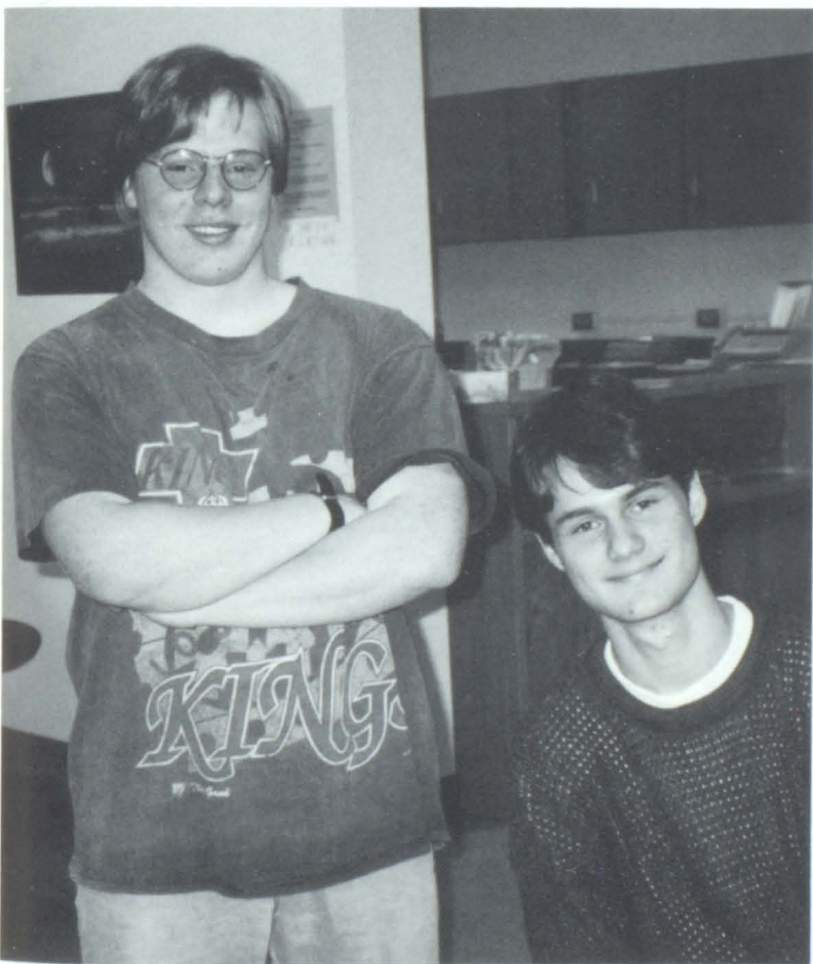


Hi everybody!
